The child is now in our orphanage living with other children. The child has 7 t-shirts, 2 shirts, 4 pants, 7 shorts, 3 slippers, one box to put the clothing, 1 backpack but old. Sleeps on the bed and has his own mattress, blankets and pillow. He is provided things needed for a person like towel, tooth brush & tooth paste, soaps, etc., etc., and is under electricity lights and the usage of abundant waters. When sickness comes, he is immediately brought to the clinic for cure just like all other children. Him and all the children receive 3 meals a day and they can eat to their belly full. They also get to eat snacks or fruits in between meals.

Describe the condition of the house and living area.

He lives with the boys in our Boys' dormitory which is a 2 story. Down stairs is built with bricks and upstairs is built with wood. The roofing is galvanized sheets. The dormitory has one toilet and one shower rooms. When study and worship they gather in the auditorium of the orphanage which is also used for our church meeting. They play at the front yard of the building.

Our orphanage was started on 1st September 2003 with a call God made to Pastor Vel Za Siamia and wife, Nute. Humanly speaking, we did not dare to do it at first so we made sure it was God's will for us to do it by prayers and searching of the Scriptures for one whole year. We found out there are lots of places in the Scriptures that God wants us to take care of orphans and widows. Among many, two of the verses that touched our hearts were Isaiah 58:6-12 and James 1:27. So, only by the obedience of God's Words and faith in His promises, we went ahead and started the orphanage with one orphan on September 1, 2003. After one week, God gave us 15 children. After a month, God gave us 30 children. We then stopped receiving more children because we were afraid that we might keep too many children that we are not able to feed or care for. However, if the Lord allows and enables us, we would like to receive as many as 120 children into our orphanage because we know that the more children we have the more souls will be saved, or at least, they learn about God and the Bible. They learn good characters, good ethics, good manners and hard work, aside from education.

So in conclusion, we do the orphanage ministry because we believe God called us to do it as we do church planting ministry.
